'The Castle in the Air' is a short opera. The music was written by Jacques Offenbach.

What is an opera?

An opera is a play in which the actors sing instead of speak - almost as in a musical. But the music in an opera is different: we call it 'classical music'.

Long before the musical was invented there were opera's: they were invented 400 years ago!



The story

Mister Offenbach sits at his piano. He wants to write some music for a new opera. What shall he compose this time? He has already made so much music...

Then the Muse appears. She's a kind of goddess who helps artists getting good ideas. She shows him some famous theatres for which he could write something. Then Pinocchio appears. That's it! Offenbach will write a play for the marionette theatre! Quickly he sets to work...:

Jeannot is a poor farmer's boy who dreams of becoming a millionaire. He travels on foot to Paris together with his girlfriend Jeannette. On the way they earn money by singing and dancing. Even the farm-animals dance along happily.

Then they meet a pedlar who has a lot of beautiful stuff. Also he has a lottery machine. With his last money, Jeannot buys a ticket. He wins!! But if you expect the story ends here, you are wrong....
