ABOUT 'The Flying Dutchman'

'The Flying Dutchman' is a performance with marionettes. Large, wooden puppets, handled by five puppeteers with strings from above.

It's an exciting adventure about an ancient ghost ship. Full of magic, with lots of beautiful music.

The music you hear was written almost 200 years ago! This 'classical music' is so famous that it is still widely played all over the world. Often in the famous Concertgebouw in Amsterdam, or the National Opera, with a very large orchestra. But this time: in the marionette theater, with only a few instruments. If you listen carefully you will hear these instruments: a piano, cello, clarinet, harmonium (that's a mini organ), drums, triangle, and all kinds of special sounds: the waves of the sea and the thunder of the storm.

The story

When the red curtain opens...

We see a girl, Senta, looking out over sea. She misses her father, captain Daland, who has been at sea for months. Senta's mother died when she was a young girl. But being near the sea, Senta doesn't feel lonely, because she loves the sea so much! She dreams of freedom and adventure.

Once upon a time, very long ago he was cursed to wander the seas eternally. He longs to leave his ship and find a home. But he can only be saved if he finds true love...


